National Medal of Honor Awards

2021 Nominee Eligibility Rules

Timeline:

All incidents or achievements occurring during the 12-month period, from January 1, 2021, thru December 31, 2021, will be considered.

Eligibility:

Correctional Officers and Supervisors Award

All publicly employed Correctional Officers and Correctional Supervisors. A supervisor is defined as any rank above Correctional Officer.

Civilian and Staff Award

It's not unusual for non-custodial staff to respond and assist correctional staff during an incident. It's also true that, on occasion, civilians outside of corrections have responded and intervened on our behalf; most notably, incidents during transport or outside details. Additionally, there may be a person who has advocated for initiatives that have significantly benefitted our continued mission in corrections. To recognize these individuals, we have established our Civilian and Staff Award. The standard in this category is purposefully broad to allow for an array of submissions for the awards.

Nominator Eligibility:

Anyone can submit a nomination for these awards. However, they must provide adequate contact information for themselves and the nominee along with supporting documentation of the incident or accomplishment. Also, consider that the more information submitted to the Selection Committee for any of the above awards, referencing the incident or achievement, the better the nominee's chances are of being selected.
